I wish to charge Defendant with the above offense (s). Under oath, I state said offense (s) were committed By Defendant on or about March 5th, 2016, in the County, and contrary to law. The essential Facts constituting the offense (s), the source of my information, and the reason my information is believable are reliable are:

On Saturday March 5th, 2016 the Public Safety Unit was conducting a sobriety checkpoint on Lower River Road at Eureka Road. I observed a black truck make a u-turn in the roadway near a sharp, blind, curve with a double yellow line. Sergeant Mario Santos and Sheriff Eric Watson pursued the vehicle beginning at approximately 1944 Hours. I responded to the area of Eads Bluff Road after Sheriff Watson stated that the vehicle had entered the west entrance of Eads Bluff Road. I observed the vehicle turn from Eads Bluff Road onto Casson Lippard Road. Upon arrival at the dead end of Casson Lippard Road I located the vehicle abandoned at approximately 1950 hours

The truck was identified as a 2002 Dodge Ram 1500 R/T registered to Charlie Mobriant from Meigs County. Within minutes of identifying the registered owner of the truck I requested Meigs County Deputies to respond to the registered owner's address at 705 Rabbit Ranch Road in Decatur, TN. A short time later I was advised that Meigs County Deputies had contact with Charlie Mobriant, the registered owner at approximately 2025 hours. I was advised that they had been told that a William Coker was the last person that he was aware had driven his vehicle. Mr. Mobriant would have unlikely had time to travel back to his residence if he were the driver of the vehicle who evaded deputies. William Coker had several Felony Warrants for his arrest from Meigs County. There was a cell phone charger in the truck but the cell phone and keys had been removed.

A K-9 tracking dog was called to the scene. The dog tracked through a wooded area approximately 3 miles before coming to the intersection of Lower River Road at Eads Bluff Road. It was believed that Mr. Coker communicated with someone to coordinate transportation away from the area.

## Continuation of Affidavit

On March 09, 2016 I spoke with the registered owner of the vehicle, Charlie Mobriant, and his brother Tyler Mobriant. Charlie Mobriant told me he went to sleep around 12 noon on March 5<sup>th</sup>. According to Mr. Charlie Mobriant, William Coker was putting headlights in the vehicle in question when he went to sleep. Mr. Charlie Mobriant did not wake up until Meigs County Deputies came to his residence to inquire about the vehicle. Mr. Tyler Mobriant provided me with William Coker's cell phone number, [REDACTED]. Mr. Tyler Mobriant called Mr. Coker and allowed me to speak with him on Mr. Tyler Mobriant's phone. Mr. Coker asked me what his warrants were for. I advised him his warrants were out of Meigs County, but that I needed to talk to him about the events which occurred Saturday night in Mr. Charlie Mobriant's truck, but I did not want to talk to him over the phone and Mr. Coker said OK. Mr. Coker said he would turn himself into Meigs County Officials and did so on March 10, 2016.

On March 11, 2016 I went to the Meigs County Jail and interviewed Mr. Coker. He signed a written waiver of his Miranda Rights and confirmed that he was a high school graduate with the ability to comprehend what he was signing. Mr. Coker did confess to operating the aforementioned truck. He stated that he panicked when he saw blue lights and made a U-Turn and fled from officers. He stated he saw officers everywhere but he continued running in the vehicle passing patrol cars and stopping at a dead end road. He confirmed that he fled on foot from the area.

*Mr. Coker's TD License was revoked as of 10-2010 with multiple additional suspensions and revocations since the original revocation.*
